## KNOW YOUR RAT POISONS

Rodenticides are killing our native fauna



I'm a Quenda not a rat

## ALWAYS...

....use **FGARs** (First-generation Anticoagulant Rodenticides) - they have a **short half life (9-30 hrs)**.

Lower concentrations in dead rats can be metabolised by native fauna and require multiple feeds to be fatal.

Use FGARs that contain: Warfarin, Coumatetralyl (Racumin), Non-anticoagulant alternative - sodium chloride

## **NEVER...**

....use **SGARs** (Second-generation Anticoagulant Rodenticides).

They kill native fauna because they:

- · can kill in one feed
- have a long half life (91 days)

Higher concentrations in dead rats kill fauna by making them drowsy and therefore vulnerable to predators and cars.
