WHAT CAN I DO TO HELP?

READ THE PACKET...DON'T BE MISLED, SGARs ARE NOT SAFE FOR OTHER ANIMALS!!

- Keep areas around your house/garden tidy and clear - no hiding spots!
- Secure entry points to your home, so the rodents can't get inside
- Don't leave food/rubbish around, secure your bins...rodents love food!
- Don't leave pet food outside. Any animal food stored outside needs to be in a sealed metal container...rodents can eat through plastic!
- Clean up bird seed, another yummy treat!
- Cover your compost and pick up fallen fruit from trees
- Make sure your pest control company does not use SGARs
- If you need to use bait, use FGARs or a rodent trap, repellent device
- Sign our petition to ban SGARs from public purchase in supermarkets and hardware stores
